

Cemetery Site Meeting notes - 15th June 2024

In attendance; Clerk, Cllrs Aries, Chambers, McAndrew and Manning
Apologies from Cllrs Koeck, Ellerbeck and McCrory

Matters raised and for follow up:

Memorial of the late Bertha Wood at top of main drive to the right – remove ivy

Scouts to be asked to wash down benches for a donation

Damaged bench at top of drive on right – check with Dean Manning

Perry memorial loose – contact family

Consider adding a memorial condition for ashes tablets to be set on a base

Fairless memorial loose – arrange fixing

Tree at rear fence near Warden bench to be trimmed

Check with the Ayres family if flower pot belongs to them

Rear fence needs repairing with 50 stakes

Volunteer group to sweep grass cuttings from memorials following each grass cut as necessary

Graves in old section to be strimmed to remove unwanted weeds and shrubbery

New hedge along bank adjoining the wood yard needs strimming and tidying

Lime suckers to be trimmed

Brambles in bushes at top of main drive to be removed

Clear teasels where original spoil heap stood to be removed in the autumn

Further meshing to be installed for plants at the base of the Sequoia trunk

St Edmunds Lane boundary tidy

Old left hand path to be left as grass

Suggestion for a warning sign at the bottom end of the old left hand path considered unnecessary as there is already a disclaimer notice at the front gate noticeboard
