Grounds maintenance: Works completed: All grounds maintenance as per contract. Sweeping at Bridge Street, Station Hill and the station area. Weed sprayed Colchester Road path. Cut back tree overhang at Millennium footpath gate entrance. Cut and litter picked Colchester Road verge. Cleared dead willow branch at river. Strimmed at FP21 plus around dog waste bin as requested by Jan Aries Parish ROW.

County Broadband: County Broadband currently arranging to hold a meeting in the village in November to promote its broadband provision. Advertising pending.

Bures Bridge repairs: Suffolk Highways has advised that the pending works to the roadbridge has been pushed back due to more urgent work elsewhere in the County and would not be included in this current financial year programme. The trip hazard on the footbridge is to be repaired. Surfacing to be inspected before the winter but highly unlikely that this will be replaced this winter.

Local Highways Panel: The feasibility study for the dropped kerb at No. 3 Bridge Street has been formally removed from the order of works following the completion of the path resurfacing along Bridge Street.

Mount Bures footpath: The Clerk had received the ECC Definitive Map Modification No. 624 (Braintree) Order dated 30th April 2018 for the new entry of FP33 Brook House Road. Clerk following up with Mount Bures Parish Council Clerk for FP33 to be named and plaque erected.
