

Contractor Works for Joint Cemetery Authority Meeting 9th September 2024

Contract grass cutting and maintenance completed as per contract

**Grass collector now being used in the extension area
Minimal cuttings now being left on the memorials**

**All pathways regularly cleared of weeds, raked and edged back
Main drive sprayed with minimal Glyphosate – monitoring
All other areas sprayed with NewWay - monitoring
Oldest left hand path left to grass over**

Front and rear gate areas tidied

All graves to be cleared of wreaths – ongoing

**Graves infilled and levelled as required
Turving of the graves as per timescale agreed
Graves to be turfed – Synnak, Violet Boyce, Harrod, Burbidge, O'Grady**

**Unwanted vegetation removed from all graves in older sections
Agreed with family for lavender bush and holly tree to be removed from the grave of the late M Bowyers – Cllr Aries to attempt to clear otherwise will be cleared by the contractor**

**Rear fence loose posts – to be stabilised with angle iron posts
50 chestnut stakes purchased for rear fence**

Nettles cleared along fenceline – Adam Norton asked to manage these nettles

Dog rose sprigs removed from shrubs at top of right hand drive as and when required

Lime tree suckers cut back

Ivy being removed from trees, walls and memorials - ongoing

**Spoil heap cleared – Adam Norton
Old spoil heap area to be cleared of brambles and vegetation**

Brown bin monitored and waste bins emptied as required – Cllr Aries

Glass vases and jam jars removed from graves – ongoing issue

Wooden posts painted at end of last row in the extension area – Cllr Aries
