

Contractor Works for Joint Cemetery Authority Meeting 10th March 2025

**Contract grass cutting and maintenance completed as per contract
Grass collector now being used in the extension area
Minimal cuttings now being left on the memorials**

**All pathways regularly cleared of weeds, raked and edged back
Main drive sprayed with minimal Glyphosate – monitoring
All other areas sprayed with NewWay - monitoring
Oldest left hand path left to grass over**

**Front and rear gate areas tidied
Front gate to be cleaned and re-painted with Black Hammerite – Nigel Norton**

**Graves infilled and levelled as required
Turving of the graves as per timescale agreed
Graves for turving – Synnak, Violet Boyce, Harrod, Burbidge, O'Grady
Pilgrim grave to be infilled and re-turfed
Unwanted vegetation removed from all graves in older sections**

50 chestnut stakes on order for rear fence from Guy Jones

Branches and cleared from behind No. 15 – JPB Landscapes
Adam Norton managing nettles along rear boundary
Laurels to be cut back along extension area boundary – JPB**

**Dog rose sprigs removed from shrubs at top of right hand drive as and when required
Lime tree suckers cut back**

**Wildflower meadow cut – more wildflower seeds to be strewn on the meadow
Ivy being removed from walls and memorials – ongoing**

**One bird box damaged - repaired – Nigel Norton
Wildflower meadow sign – repaired onto new post – Ron Wright**

No dog sign purchased for rear field gate – Atlas Signs

**Mulch delivered by George Blake for woodyard boundary hedging – Cllr Aries and
Cllr Chambers spread mulch around the saplings**

Brown bin monitored and waste bins emptied as required – Cllr Aries

Glass vases and jam jars removed from graves – ongoing issue

Shed to be re-treated in the spring – member volunteers

All graves to be cleared of wreaths – ongoing
