The process to **refresh** the Plan started with a **workshop** meeting in the Community Centre on Monday, **27th February 2017** to which all villagers were invited. **Over one hundred people participated** in the workshop.

Issues and areas of concern to you identified at the workshop have been incorporated into the attached questionnaire so that we can **seek the views of the whole community**. Where boxes Y or N are shown, please tick as appropriate. It should not take too long to complete.

We would be grateful if you could complete the questionnaire in accordance with the instructions. Please do your best to answer as many questions as you feel able, as fully as possible. It is important that as many people as possible contribute their answers. But you do not have to answer any question you don't want to. Parents are requested to **encourage the younger members of their families to complete their separate survey**. All responses are important. This process will be completely anonymous.
