This Order is made by Essex County Council (“the authority”) under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 (“the 1980 Act”) because it appears to the authority that in the interest of the owner of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.



The landowner has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this order and any expenses incurred in the order making and bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.

Braintree District Council have been consulted and have consented to the making of the order as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

- 1) The public right of way over the land situated at Farriers Farm known as Footpath 5 Bures Hamlet in the District of Braintree and shown by a bold continuous black line on the order map BUR 5A contained in this order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this order shall be stopped up after 35 days from the date of confirmation of this order

- 2) There shall at the end of 28 days from the date of confirmation of this order be a public footpath over land situated at Farriers Farm known as Footpath 5 Bures Hamlet in the District of Braintree as described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken black line on the order map BUR 5A contained in this order.

SCHEDULE

(PART 1)

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY

- (i) A part length of Footpath 5 Bures Hamlet of unknown width shown by a bold continuous black line on the order map commencing from point **A** at grid reference 58954,23373 south of Farriers Farm running in a generally west south westerly direction then a generally westerly direction across the field for a total distance of approximately 344 metres to point **C** at grid reference 58921,23368.
- (ii) A further section of Footpath 5 Bures Hamlet commencing from point **D** at grid reference 58913,23370 running in a generally north westerly direction through the trees for a total distance of approximately 225 metres to point **F** at grid reference 58893,23380.

(PART 2)

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY

- (i) A footpath being 2 metres in width shown by a bold broken black line on the order map commencing at the aforementioned point **A** running in a southerly then west south westerly direction along the field boundary for a distance of approximately 306 metres to point **B** at grid reference 58926,23363 then continuing in a north westerly direction for a final distance of approximately 80 metres to the aforementioned point **C** where it continues unaffected.
- (ii) A footpath being 2 metres in width shown by a bold broken black line on the order map commencing at the aforementioned point **D** running in a north westerly direction along the edge of the wood for a distance of approximately 215 metres to point **E** at grid reference 58896,23383 then continuing in a south westerly direction for a final distance of approximately 47 metres to the aforementioned point **F** where it continues unaffected.
